

### Political Science

- 1. Only 2.3% of Political Science majors are hired as Congressional Interns.
- 2. The ENTJ personality type is well-equipped for Political Science. Do you know yours?
- 3. Political Science graduates hired as Campaign Managers can expect industry growth to be 5.2%.
- 4. 24.8% of Political Science graduates have a master's degree.

### Computer Science

### Accounting
